

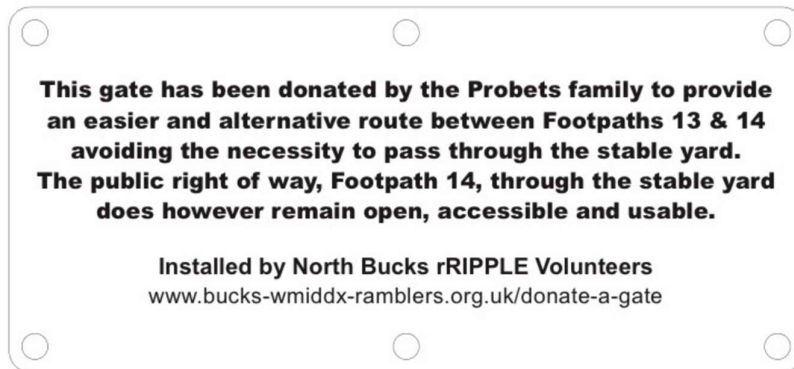
North Bucks rRIPPLE
(ramblers Repairing & Improving Public Paths for Leisure & Exercise)
Activity Report – 1 June 2022 – 31 August 2022

Copies of before & after photos of all work are available on request. Man hours include some travel time. DaG = Donate a Gate. CAMS (Countryside Access Management System) is a reference used by BC (Buckinghamshire Council) for work requests. All work is requested and authorized by Alastair McVail, BC North Bucks PRow Officer, or Jon Clark, BC Senior Strategic Access Officer. OPAG = Oving Paths Action Group. PG = Pedestrian Gate (e.g. Centrewire Marlow); KG = Kissing Gate (e.g. Centrewire Woodstock). DFU = Dinton with Ford & Upton.

“Installed to NB rRIPPLE standard” means the following: “Marlow gate installed c/w 22 mm washer, hinges greased, eye bolt thread copper greased and latch oiled. Two 1.8 m x 100 x 100 UC4 15 year Redwood posts c/w Postsaver sleeves are attached to the gate’s H-frame with two 10 mm diameter coach screws. The posts and H frame are tamped in firmly with copious quantities of stones. Improved by the Ramblers square decals and BC way markers fitted as appropriate.” KG slightly different as only one post needed and as from 30/1/19 we are now putting half a 20 kg bag of Remix Rapid Post Fix (£4.50 per bag) on top of each of the two galvanized “feet” of the two hoops. Arisings, i.e. the timber from the old stile is cut up by chain saw and removed from site unless stated otherwise.

1/6/22 Thornborough. Sent comprehensive explanation to Mac on how to remove a DaG plaque to replace it with a new one. Newly acquired plaques include the names of additional grandchildren.

1/6/22 Ickford Gate 284 ICK/14/1 at SP650069. Peter & Gillian Probets DaG. Non Buckinghamshire Council job. Installed Marlow PG to NB rRIPPLE standard. Attached two strands of barbed wire to each side. 3x6=18 man hours. Fitted plaque – see below. PAndrew & Mike Kershaw. 25 miles. Peter 18.



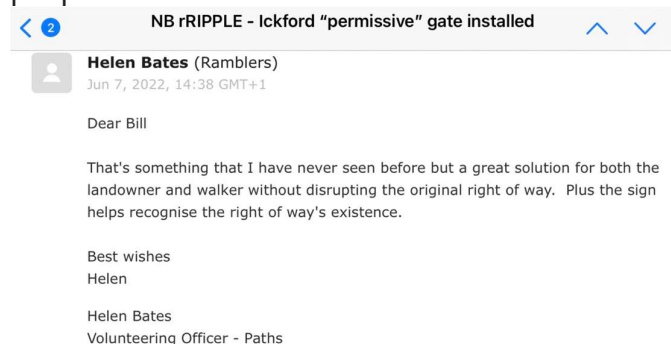
1/6/22 Ickford Gate 285 ICK/14/1 at SP650069. Replaced 1.0 m timber gate in dilapidated non-functioning kissing gate into stable yard. Dismantled what remained of dilapidated KG. Fitted replacement second-hand 0.9 m timber PG closing against new 1.8 m x 100 x 100 closing post c/w Postsaver sleeve. Fitted coiled spring closer and made good adjoining timber rails. Fitted cut-off 200 mm coach screw for self-closing, self-latching feature. Nice job! Fitted several additional way marker discs to clearly indicate route of public footpath through the stable yard. 2x6=12 man hours. B & Peter Jordain.

3/6/22 Ickford ICK/14/1 DaG at SP650070. Applied for CAMS for wobbly, one step, no hand post S2G. Ickford PC to contribute £120; Ramblers & Buckinghamshire Council to fund the rest.

4/6/22 Dinton with Ford & Upton (Westlington) DFU13/1 at SP761104. Replaced gate with broken hasp. Fitted “Improved by The Ramblers” decal. 1 man hour. B. 10 miles.

6/6/22 Oakley OAK/14/1 at SP635120. Paul Kilpin said he'd request a DaG contribution from Oakley parish council at their meeting on 7/6/22. Requested plaque from Impact Signs.

7/6/22 Ramblers HQ. Nice comment re Ickford "permissive path" and Gate 284. See 1/6/22 for plaque details.



7/6/22 Ickford ICK/14/1 DaG at SP650070 received CAMS from Rose for PG.

7/6/22 Oakley OAK/14/1 at SP635120 received CAMS from Rose for two KGs.

9/6/22 Web page. Got Lawrence Jones to rearrange the DaG application forms to an up-front position on web page. Other documents are out of date such as plagiarize-able parish council application form.

10/6/22 CRFC Received delivery of 5 Marlow and 5 Woodstock gates from Buckinghamshire Council. 15 miles.

11/6/22 Waddesdon Estate. Sent suggested plaque wording to Jerry.

14/6/22 Oakley Gate 285 OAK/14/5 CAMS 97466 at SP634118 Peter & Wendy Hopcroft and Oakley Parish Council DaG. Gap in new fencing - installed Woodstock KG to NB rRIPPLE standard. 3.5x7=25 man hours. AllenJoeK+B. 30 miles; Peter 15; Joe 35; Allen 26.

14/6/22 Oakley Gate 286 OAK/14/5 CAMS 97467 at SP635120 Peter & Wendy Hopcroft and Oakley Parish Council DaG. Fencing contractor removed old stile leaving a gap in new fencing - installed Woodstock KG to NB rRIPPLE standard beside field gate on roadside. 3.5x7=24 man hours. Peter 15 miles.

14/6/22 CRFC. Collected Marlow gate. 1 man hour. B. 15 miles.

22/6/22 Ickford ICK/14/1 at SP650069. Received £120 from Ickford PC for donation towards cost of Gate 288.

22/6/22 Buckinghamshire Council. Made payment of £5,000 from Donate-a-Gate fund towards purchase of next tranche of gates.

27/6/22 Impact Signs. Collected three sets of DaG plaques. B. 1 man hour. 20 miles.

28/6/22 Ickford Gate 288 ICK/14/1 CAMS 97468 at SP650069. Ickford Parish Council DaG - plaque fitted as we had one spare. Dismantled awkward 3-rail (1 a double rail), 1 wobbly step, no hand post stile. Installed Marlow PG to NB rRIPPLE standard. Made good two strands of barbed wire to one side. Generally tidied up site for landowner. 4x5=20 man hours. AndrewBMikeKershaw + Keith Lister of Ickford and member of Aylesbury Land Rover Fanatics Club. 40 miles inc. to Worminghall pub and Oakley to fit plaque to Gate 287.

28/6/22 Oakley Gate 287 - Fitted plaque: Donated by Peter & Wendy Hopcroft and Oakley PC. Met Roger Simms of Quainton and also Peter Hopcroft.

28/6/22 Quainton - Mathew's Way. Met Roger Simms in Oakley who said he'd make enquiries about converting the last few remaining stiles on Mathew's Way to gates with the landowners with whom he generally has a good relationship.

4/7/22 Impact Signs. Collected Waddesdon Estates plaques. 1 man hour. B. 15 miles.

4/7/22 CRFC Collected 10 buckets of stones and 2 KGs. 2x1.5=3 man hours. BJoe. 20 miles.

5/7/22 Waddesdon Gate 289 WAD/7B/1 CAMS 97076 at SP753157. Dismantled 3-rail + 1 raisable rotating rail; 1-low step stile. Installed Woodstock KG to NB rRIPPLE standard apart from no Re-mix concrete used as hoops positioned outside horse paddock and so not subject to animal damage. 3x7=21 man hours. AndrewMikeP. Peter 16 miles. Fitted Waddesdon Estates LLP in partnership with The Ramblers and Buckinghamshire Council plaque.

5/7/22 Waddesdon Gate 290 WAD/7B/1 CAMS 97077 at SP752158. Dismantled 3-rail + 1 raisable rotating rail; 1-low step stile. Installed Woodstock KG to NB rRIPPLE standard apart from no Re-mix concrete used as hoops positioned outside horse paddock and so not subject to animal damage. 3x7=21 man hours. BJohnJoe. 25 miles; John 20. Fitted Waddesdon Estates LLP in partnership with The Ramblers and Buckinghamshire Council plaque.



8/7/22 Dinton. Terry Heath emailed about firming a small volunteer team to strim paths. Rosemary Bird said DFU/4/1 opposite Dinton cricket club is particularly bad.

8/7/22 Marsh Gibbon MGI/9A/1 CAMS 89935 at SP656230. Recce to check completion of stile-to-gap (which is complete) and another potential S2G on MGI/9/2 at SP655233. Mrs Line of Leopold Farm confirmed the S2G is on their land. Her son Nick, the farmer, was out haymaking. 2 man

hours. B. 30 miles.

9/7/22 Marsh Gibbon MGI/9A/1 CAMS 89935 at SP656230. Tel con with Nick Line to congratulate him on his stile to gap and to discuss the potential S2G - see above. He said that on reflection he would actually like a gate where he made the gap after all. He also insisted that he's quite happy with the stile on MGI/9/2 at SP655233 and doesn't even want a kissing gate.

11/7/22 Marsh Gibbon. Sent email to PC Clerk and Liz Taylor about our need for a local champion and about the chat with Nick Line.

12/7/22 Marsh Gibbon. Sent email to clerk to explain purpose and function of having a local footpaths champion.

12/7/22 Waddesdon. Submitted South East Walker article for approval by Waddesdon Estates to Isobel O'Kelly.

14/7/22 Quainton Matthew's Way at Denham Farm up on the hill. Roger Simms messaged with farmer Andrew Lloyd's contact details and said it might now be worth chatting to him about a couple of S2Gs.

15/7/22 U3A Walk Chearsley to Cuddington. Came across very awkward stile on LNW/2/2 at SP728113.

17/7/22 Chearsley CHR/4/3 at SP725108. Emailed Anthony Adams to ask if he could negotiate landowner permission for an S2G.

17/7/22 Cuddington/Lower Winchendon. Emailed Ken Birkby enquiring as to whether he is aware of our activities. Included photos of very awkward stile on LNW/2/2 at SP728113.

17/7/22 Centrewire. Emailed Jed Wragg about broken D hasp on Marlow gate at bridge over the River Thame at Lower Winchendon mill. See "fix" 22/7/22 below.

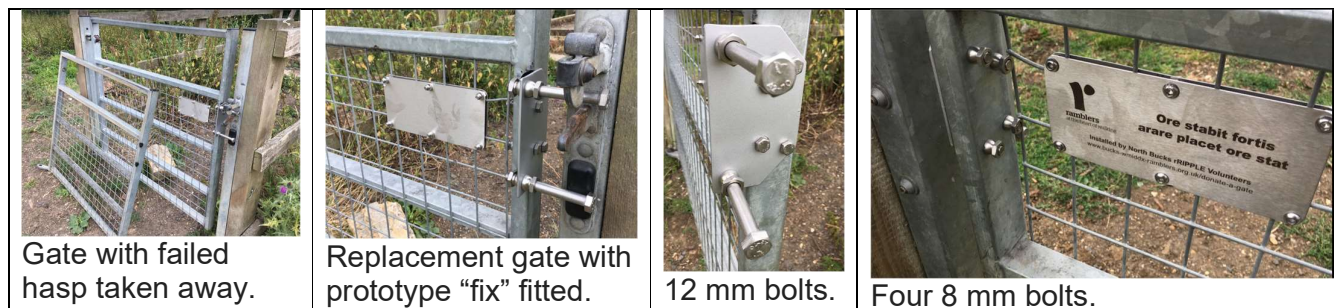
20/7/22 Brill Gate 291 BRI/10/2 CAMS 97333 at SP643131. Hannah Gutteridge DaG. Dismantled 4-rail, 2-step, 1-hand post stile. Installed Marlow PG to NB rRIPPLE standard. Made good 4 rails to one side. Fitted plaque - In memory of Mike and Sandy Gutteridge. 3x7=21 man hours. JerryMP. Jerry 20 miles; Peter 10. Met Hannah Hulme Hunter, Brill Parish Council Footpaths Rep.

20/7/22 Brill Gate 292 BRI/10/2 CAMS 97334 at SP643131. Hannah Gutteridge DaG. Dismantled sheep-netted, 4-rail, 2-step, 1-hand post stile. Cleared undergrowth and nettles. Installed Woodstock KG to NB rRIPPLE standard. Made good 4 rails to one side. Fitted plaque - "It's a good day to be human". 3x7=21 man hours. BKMike. 40 miles equiv. Met Hannah Hulme Hunter, Brill Parish Council Footpaths Rep.

21/7/22 Briants of Risborough. Collected 20 timber posts. 1 man hour. B. 15 miles.

22/7/22 CRFC. Collected KG and stones. BK. 2 man hours. 15 miles.

22/7/22 Lower Winchendon LNW/10B/2 at SP737120. Replaced Centrewire gate with failed hasp with our prototype bolt-on "fix" kit. 2 man hours. 10 miles. This design proved to be fit for purpose and has been adopted by us.



25/7/22 Oakley OAK/4/2 CAMS 94595 at SP661117. Met Trevor Johnson at Addingrove Farm to discuss access to site and an additional S2G on his side of the hedge. Additional CAMS requested from Rose. CAMS 97858 received. 1 man hour. B. 15 miles.

27/7/22 CRFC. Collected one Marlow. 1 man hour. B. 15 miles.

27/7/22 Gates. Emailed Rose to request a delivery of 5 Marlows and 5 Woodstocks.

2/8/22 Oakley Gate 293 OAK/4/2 CAMS 94595 at SP661117. Westerly of two adjacent jobs either side of thick hedge. Dismantled high, awkward and potentially dangerous 4-rail, 2-collapsed steps, 1-hand post stile. Installed Woodstock KG to NB rRIPPLE standard. Hard and stoney ground. Fitted four rails adjacent and across ditch but no handrail beside footbridge. 4x7=28 man hours. AndrewJoeJerryM. Andrew 20 miles; Joe 15.

2/8/22 Oakley Gate 294 OAK/4/2 CAMS 97858 at SP661117. Easterly of two adjacent jobs either side of thick hedge. Cleared overhanging hedge and brambles. Dismantled 4-rail, 2-steps, 1-hand post stile. Installed Marlow PG to NB rRIPPLE standard. Hard and stoney ground. 3x7=21 man hours. BMikeP. (B mostly seagulling). 30 miles.

2/8/22 DFU/42/2 and BRI/16/3 at SP664117 - two stiles either side of a completely collapsed footbridge across quite a deep ditch. Cleared brambles and undergrowth with hedge trimmer. 1 man hour. B. Before and after photos of clearance below:



3/8/22 Dinton with Ford & Upton DFU/42/2 on Aylesbury Ring recce for four S2Gs. Met with land-owners Sally Hall and Mark Barlow. Requested four CAMSs from Rose. 3 man hours. B. 20 miles.

4/8/22 Dinton with Ford & Upton Aylesbury Ring. DFU/42/2 received CAMS 97578 to convert stile to Marlow gate at SP788087; CAMS 89905 for Stile to Marlow at SP784089; two CAMS 97941/2 to replace two stiles at SP785088. Emailed Stephen Putman of Aylesbury Ramblers to advertise potential DaGs on the Aylesbury Ring that might be of interest for potential donors. See map below.



4/8/22 Lower Winchendon. Talked to Angie Birks, cattle grazer, who said she would open negotiations with Robert Spencer Bernard about four S2KGs, three near the mill and one up at the bottom of Tibbs Lane.



5/8/22 Land Rover broken into whilst parked in Haddenham and c£1,250 replacement value of tools stolen. This included a Stihl battery chainsaw, three battery drills and assorted tools.

8/8/22 Dorton DOT/7/1 recce with Peter for two CAMSs for two S2KGs at SP681148. 2 man hours. BP. 20 miles.

9/8/22 Dinton with Ford & Upton Gate 295 DFU/4/3 CAMS 97578 at SP788087. Cleared vast amount of very prickly hawthorn hedging and transported it on trailer across the field suitable place to dump it. Dismantled high and wide awkward wobbly 2-step, 3- double-rail rails, stile. Installed Marlow PG to NB rRIPPLE standard. Reattached two strands of barbed wire to both sides of installation. Left arisings on site hidden in hedge. Cleared passageway in north westerly direction through hedge of overhanging and encroaching overgrowth. 3x6=28 man hours. BJoeJohn. 20 miles; Joe 20.

9/8/22 Dorton DOT/7/1 requested two CAMSs for two S2KGs at SP681148.

14/8/22 Marsh Gibbon. Responded to query from PC clerk re Nick Line's request for a gate rather than a gap. Explained funding of gates.

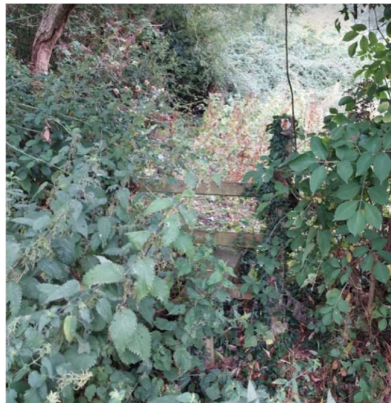
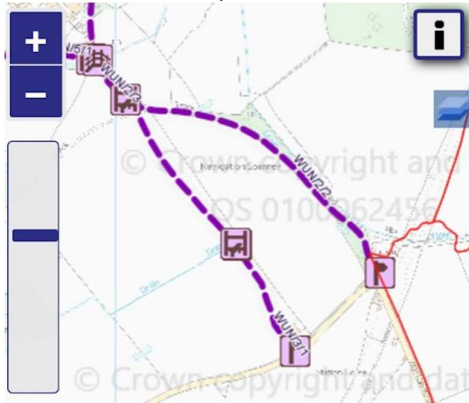

Minutes of a meeting of the Area Executive Committee held on Tuesday 16th August 2022 in the Meeting Room, Wendover Library, High Street, Wendover, Buckinghamshire, HP22 6DU, starting at 7.30pm.

- 51/22 North Bucks rRIPPLE:** Bill Piers had reported that the group was installing gates on the Aylesbury Ring; they were likely to reach their 300th gate shortly. Tools worth £1250 had been stolen from Bill's Land Rover and were not covered by his personal, or Ramblers' insurance. It was agreed that the Area would offer to purchase replacements (as Ramblers' property) subject to agreement on measures to minimise further risk (proposed by Kate Lambourne, seconded by Robert Jones-Owen).

17/8/22 Dorton DOT/7/1 Received CAMSS 98097/8 at SP680146 and SP680148.

17/8/22 Wotton Underwood. Contacted PC, Andy Windmill, to ask if they would be interested in getting any help from us wrt PROW. He responded with some photos including a stile at the junction of WUN/2/3, WUN/2/2 and WUN/3/1.



19/8/22 Land Rover. New driver's door lock fitted.

20/8/22 Toolstation Thame. Purchased coach screws, spanners, booster cables to replace stolen items. 1 man hour. 15 miles.

22/8/22 Briants of Risborough. Purchased Stihl battery chainsaw to replace stolen one and also five bags of Premix. 1 man hour. 15 miles.

23/8/22 Dinton with Ford & Upton Gate 296 DFU/4/3 CAMS 97941 at SP785088 Dinton Beer Festival DaG. Dismantled dilapidated 4-rail (Top one double); 2-step; 1-hand post stile. Installed Marlow PG to NB rRIPPLE standard. Used recycled gate with broken hasp from Notley Farm with our fix kit fitted. Made good 2 strands of barbed wire to one side and 3 short rails to other side. 3.5x6=21 man hours. AllenKP+B. Allen 20 miles; Peter 20.

23/8/22 Dinton with Ford & Upton Gate 297 DFU/4/3 CAMS 97941 at SP785088. Aylesbury Ramblers plaque already fitted for Jim Robinson to this gate which was a recycled one with a broken hasp from Notley Farm with our fix kit fitted. Cleared considerable amount of overgrowth including hawthorn trees using newly replaced Stihl battery chainsaw replacing the one stolen from the Land Rover on 5/8/22. Dismantled awkward 3-rail (Bottom one double); 1-step; 1-hand post stile. In-

stalled Marlow PG to NB rRIPPLE standard. 3.5x6=21 man hours. JoeMike Ian Mackey+B. 20 miles; Joe 12.

25/8/22 Grove. Contacted both Rose and Gill King wrt landowner info discussed 9/5/22. Rose suggested contacting Grove PC.

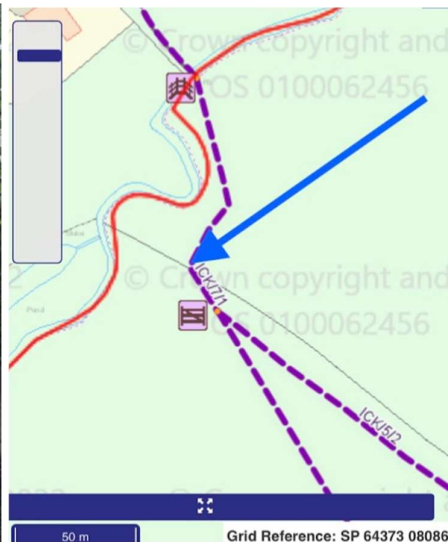
