Activity Report – 1 September 2022 – 30 November 2022

Copies of before & after photos of all work are available on request. Man hours include some travel time. DaG = Donate a Gate. CAMS (Countryside Access Management System) is a reference used by BC (Buckinghamshire Council) for work requests. All work is requested and authorized by Alastair McVail, BC North Bucks PRow Officer, or Jon Clark, BC Senior Strategic Access Officer. OPAG = Oving Paths Action Group. PG = Pedestrian Gate (e.g. Centrewire Marlow); KG = Kissing Gate (e.g. Centrewire Woodstock). DFU = Dinton with Ford & Upton.

“Installed to NB rRIPPLE standard” means the following: “Marlow gate installed c/w 22 mm washer, hinges greased, eye bolt thread copper greased and latch oiled. Two 1.8 m x 100 x 100 UC4 15 year Redwood posts c/w Postsaver sleeves are attached to the gate’s H-frame with two 10 mm diameter coach screws. The posts and H frame are tamped in firmly with copious quantities of stones. Improved by the Ramblers square decals and BC way markers fitted as appropriate.” KG slightly different as only one post needed and as from 30/1/19 we are now putting half a 20 kg bag of Remix Rapid Post Fix (£4.50 per bag) on top of each of the two galvanized “feet” of the two hoops. Arisings, i.e. the timber from the old stile is cut up by chain saw and removed from site unless stated otherwise.

Working in partnership with Waddesdon Estates LLP and Buckinghamshire Council, six RIPPLers in two teams of three installed a pair of kissing gates either side of a paddock at Waddesdon Stud in early July. It is hoped the new gates will be the start of a plan to upgrade stiles across the estate's footpath network. The partnership wants to encourage walkers to use and stick to the public rights of way at all times and the estate works hard to ensure its paths are open, safe and easy to use. We look forward to continuing our work with Waddesdon Estates LLP and Buckinghamshire Council over the next year or so.

1/9/22 Grove SLA/16/1 at SP9206222595. Emailed Grove parish council clerk re rickety stile with a steep drop in the hedge alongside the Grand Union Canal just north of Church Lock at Grove at junction of footpath SLA/16/1 and SLA/13/1 (the towpath).

6/9/22 Grove. Gill King WhatsApped to say canals and rivers trust now aware of situation.

6/9/22 Ford Gate 298 DFU/42/2 CAMS 89905 at SP784089. Dinton Beer Festival DaG (1of2). Dismantled 2-rail, 1 very low step, awkward barrier stile. Trimmed back hedge on one side. Retained two existing posts and installed Marlow PG to NB rRIPPLE standard. 4x5=20 man hours. BKM and Angus Myles on his first outing with us. 20 miles.

9/9/22 CRFC. Loaded and collected 15 buckets of stones in trailer. 2x1.5=3 man hours. BK 15 miles; Keith 15.

9/9/22 Long Crendon LCR/9/2 at SP707086. Recce with Peter to check out damaged stile. 2 man hours. BP. 15 miles; Peter 10. Subsequently Nick Reynolds, Notley Farm landowner, agreed to fund a £350 DaG. Emailed completed application form to Nick Reynolds on 11/9/22.

12/9/22 Centrewire hasp failures. Inspected two further gates with problems on CUD/9/1 at SP736102 and on HAD/19/1 at SP738099 beside the A418, which was previously welded.

13/9/22 CRFC Collected 2KGs for Gates 299 & 300. 2 man hours. BJoe. 15 miles. Joe 15. Joe picked up long series drills and two plaques.

13/9/22 Expenses. Emails with John Esslemont wrt claims for replacement tools.

16/9/22 Waddesdon Estates. Jerry met with Chris Leach. Several potential S2KGs were discussed and agreed.

18/9/22 Long Crendon LCR/7/4 at SP712087. Tony Clark of Thame & Wheatley Ramblers contacted us wrt the perennial flooding problem down by the River Thame. We responded to say we'd talk to landowner Nick Reynolds when we install his gate.

18/9/22 Celebration Sunday lunch at Seven Stars Dinton of 300th gate to be installed on 21/9/22.



21/9/22 Dorton Gate 299 DOT/7/1 CAMS 98008 at SP680146. Dismantled 3-rail, 2-step, 1-hand post wired stile. Installed Woodstock KG to NB rRIPPLE standard except no Remix used as corral outside field. Trimmed hedge. 4x7=28 man hours. AndrewMJerry + James Spratley, new Buckinghamshire Council PRow Officer. Andrew 20 miles.

21/9/22 Dorton Gate 300 DOT/7/1 CAMS 98007 at SP680148 Peter & Jane Smith DaG. Dismantled 3-rail (One double), 1-step, no hand post, sheep-netted stile. Installed Woodstock KG to NB rRIPPLE standard. Trimmed hedge. Fitted blue electric fencing continuity tube. 5x7=35 man hours. BDKPJoe. 30 miles; Joe 30; Peter12. Fitted plaque.

22/9/22 Quainton Called Andrew Lloyd re awkward stiles on Quainton hill. He wishes to stick with stiles and said there's an openable field gate immediately next to the most awkward one.

22/9/22 Quainton QUA/15/1 at SP747200. Email from Brian Fludgate requesting our help to replace a timber KG with a Woodstock KG. After tel con he asked us to install it. Requested CAMS from Rose on 26/9/22.

27/9/22 Long Crendon LCR/7/4 & Haddenham HAD/20/1 at SP712088. Collected Tony Clark of Thame & Wheatley Ramblers and together met with Nick Reynolds of Notley Farm. Site visit to perennially flooded location at Notley mill. Agreed upon building an approximately 20 m long embankment to link end of bridge to embankment beside mill race. Nick to supply 100 tons of chalk and then to top it off with 20 tons of 70/40 aggregate. Agreed to raise field gate's hinges to ensure it can still be opened. Also agreed to fitting Marlow sized gates to both ends of bridge and to build up ground level on Haddenham side of bridge with 20 tons of Type 1 aggregate. 2x2=4 man hours. B & Tony C. 20 miles.

27/9/22 Long Crendon LCR/7/4 & Haddenham HAD/20/1, both at SP712088. Requested CAMSs for gates at each end of bridge.

28/9/22 Centrewire gates. Repaired 2 gates with broken hasps with doubled up plates to provide added strength. 2 man hours. B.

28/9/22 Paid Notley Farm £1,320 towards flood alleviation project.

28/9/22 Received £200 from Tony Clark towards flood alleviation project.

27/9/22 Long Crendon LCR/7/4 & Haddenham HAD/20/1 at SP712088. Sent email to HaddSWAC to request donation towards flood alleviation project. Cynthia Floud said not appropriate for HaddSWAC and to ask Haddenham PC.

29/9/22 CRFC. Collected Marlow gate. 1 man hour. B. 15 miles.

29/9/22 Cuddington CUD/9/1 at SP736102. Contacted farmer James Gibson and replaced broken Centrewire Marlow with new one. Took broken one home for fixing with NB rRIPPLE double thickness bracket fix kit. 1 man hour. 6 miles. B.

29/9/22 Toolstation Thame. Collected 12 mm washers, 8 mm nuts & bolts for our fix kit.

30/9/22 Long Crendon LCR/7/4 & Haddenham HAD/20/1 at SP712088. Emailed Long Crendon PC to request contribution towards flood alleviation project.

30/9/22 Tel con James Heybrook. He confirmed £140 cheque on its way from Cheersley residents and £50 received from Councillor Nic Brown, Chair Cheersley PC. Tel con with Peter Gulland and subsequently received £100 contribution.

3/10/22 Long Crendon LCR/9/2. Email from Greg Lismore, Clerk to PC, re surface improvements and dilapidated stile. Responded to say we have the stile on our list but don't get involved in surface improvement work.

3/10/22 Received £25 from Andy Wight of Cheersley/HaddSWAC; £50 from Charles Boon; £30 from Shushana Kendrick (Penelope Creighton-Ward).

4/10/22 Received £40 from Simon & Gill Markwick of Shoreham by Sea.

5/10/22 Haddenham Gate 301 HAD/20/1 CAMS 98367 at SP712088 Flood Alleviation Project DaG. Removed narrow Stratford gate welded to bridge railings using angle grinder. Installed Marlow gate raised high enough to clear likely anticipated flood levels. Fixed gate to two telegraph pole posts provided by farmer set into deep holes. 3x7=21 man hours. BKMike. 15 miles.

5/10/22 Long Crendon Gate 302 LCR/7/4 CAMS 98491 at SP713087 Flood Alleviation Project DaG. Installed Marlow gate raised high enough to clear likely anticipated flood levels. Fixed gate

to two telegraph pole posts provided by farmer set into deep holes. $3 \times 7 = 21$ man hours. JerryJoeM. Joe 20 miles.

5/10/22 Received £10 from Catherine Mary McToal, £200 from Long Crendon PC and £200 from Chearsley PC; £100 from Brian Bowman; £5 cash from passing walker; £20 cash from Ros Howarth.

10/10/22 Received £50 donation from Lorraine Gooch of Dinton. 26/10/22 Received £60 from Rosemary Bird on behalf of Stone, Haddenham & Dinton Simply Walk Group.

11/10/22 Long Crendon Gate 303 CAMS 98276 at SP707086 Nick Reynolds of Notley Farm DaG. Cleared up collapsed and derelict stile. Installed Marlow PG to NB rRIPPLE standard except that two recycled cut-to-length telegraph poles used instead of 100 x 100 posts. Fitted plaque. $5 \times 5 = 25$ man hours. AllenAndrewBJoeM. 20 miles; Joe 15; Allen 26.

11/10/22 GiftAid. John Esslemont, Area Treasurer, said we'd received £1,100.14 from HMRC.

12/10/22 Received £100 donation from Bruce Alexander; £100 from Aylesbury Ramblers; £100 from HaddSWAC (Haddenham Safe Walking & Cycling). Total received in donations: £1,620 – this is £300 above initial expenditure on 28/9/22 which will pay for two DaG S2Gs, Gates 301 & 302, at either end of foot bridge over the River Thames.

13/10/22 Oakley DaG on OAK/34/1 at SP645123 - Requested CAMS for a S2KG. Tel con Paul Kilpin; £150 donation from Julie Bernard; plaque to read: "In memory of Margaret". Received CAMS 98394 on 18/10/22.

13/10/22 Cuddington CUD/2/1 at SP736114 - Requested CAMS for a S2KG near Holymans Barn.

13/10/22 Cuddington CUD/2/1 at SP737113 - Requested CAMS for a S2KG at end of Tibbys Lane.

25/10/22 Waddesdon Gate 304 WAD/12/1 CAMS 98338 at SP760131. Dismantled 4-rail, 1-collapsed step, no hand post stile. Installed Marlow PG to NB rRIPPLE standard. Used one retained upright railway sleeper as one post. $4 \times 5 = 20$ man hours. BJerryKP. 20 miles, Peter 13.

25/10/22 Long Crendon LCR/9/4 at SP714097. Met with Nick Reynolds to discuss problems with narrow footbridge over brook. Nick said Long Crendon PC had asked if he could improve it. We said not within our remit but would support any improvements. $4 \times 1 = 4$ man hours. BJerryKP. 10 miles.

1/11/22 Waddesdon Gate 305 WAD/7B/1 CAMS 98369 at SP754155. Dismantled 4-double row rails, 2-high steps, 1-hand post stile. Installed 0.9 m timber gate with self-closing gate furniture. Installed 2.1 m x 100 x 100 way-marker post using stones to support it but no Postsaver sleeve. Refitted 4-rails and painted timber "Dogs on Leads" sign. $4 \times 6 = 24$ man hours. BJerryKP. 20 miles; Peter 16.

2/11/22 Quainton QUA/15/1 CAMS 98277 at SP747200. Recce of site. Met with local resident and saw Woodstock KG in stock ready for us to install. Confirmed with Brian Fludgate that we'd install it on 8/11/22.

2/11/22 Buckinghamshire Council emailed (Jon Clark) to say Secure-a-Field are offering gates at a price comparable with Centrewire's prices. In our experience we've found Secure-a-Field's gates are considerably stronger and more robust than Centrewire's.

3/11/22 Long Crendon LCR/7/4 at SP713087. Request for authorisation for a gate to replace low barrier at end of footbridge. Email from Alastair saying Nick Reynolds of Notley Farm needs to email a request for a form to complete to get Highways Agency authorisation to install a gate.

3/11/22 Dinton with Ford & Upton at Eythrope DFU/2/1 at SP769130 emailed Mike Lambert of Starveall Farm yet again to ask if he'd dumped any rubble in the two dips at the last two stiles near Eyethrope. Unfortunately he has been busy and hasn't sorted the problem. This ongoing problem caused very considerable inconvenience to a Haddenham U3A Walk on Friday 18/11/22 unable to wade through deep water and having to seek an alternative route.



4/11/22 CRFC Dropped off some arisings and collected two gates. 1 man hour. B. 10 miles.

4/11/22 Haddenham HAD/19/1 at SP738099. Swapped over yet another broken Centrewire Marlow gate, one that we'd had welded a year or so ago to repair it which subsequently rusted and failed again. 1 man hour. B. 10 miles.

6/11/22 Long Crendon LCR/11/1 Dilapidated stile at College Farm. Email from Sandy Hooper, parish councillor, asking about how to go about S2G or S2KG. Responded helpfully.

7/11/22 Cuddington CUD/2/1 at SP737113 and 736114 – Requested two CAMS for two S2KGs. Site meeting with Ken Birkby, PC Chair, and local residents James Stonham and Richard Stanczyc. 1 man hour. B. 10 miles. 9/11/22 Received padlock code for field gate into site from Savills.

8/11/22 Quainton Gate 306 QUA/15/1 CAMS 98277 at SP747200. Assisted Brian Fludgate and Mike Evans of Quainton to install a Woodstock KG that Buckinghamshire Council had given them to replace a rotten timber KG. Provided them with training, guidance and instruction so that they can install a KG by themselves in future. They were surprised at just how much was involved. Dismantled remains of collapsed timber KG cutting buck overgrowth and some surface undergrowth. Excavated site to expose and reuse two massive York Stone like slabs to make firm walkway through corral. 5x5=25 man hours. BKMicheal + Brian & Mike. 25 miles.

8/11/22 Quainton QUA/15/1 at SP749201. Replaced horse chewed timber gate at kissing gate with the better condition gate recycled gate from SP747200 – see above. Salvaged the 45° fittings to be reused elsewhere such as Cuddington.

9/11/22 Long Crendon LCR/7/4 CAMS 98491 at SP713087. Received CAMS for new gate (Gate 302) at Notley Mill following request by farmer/landowner for authorisation for change from non-listed stile to a pedestrian gate.

9/11/22 Tel con with Ray Maguire of Chiltern Society's South Oxfordshire path maintenance team to obtain a second 45° kit for Cuddington KGs.

9/11/22 Centrewire. Tel con with Jed Wragg. He said he'd courier two fix kits for the broken gates for us to try out.

9/11/22 Long Crendon Gate 302 LCR/7/4 Received CAMS 98491 at SP7130867 for new gate at Notley Mill.

9/11/22 Weedon WEE/4/1 CAMS 91335 at SP815175. Wendy Kett, Footpaths Parish Councillor, responded to an email requesting an update to say this S2KG no longer a priority as there's a simple by pass along WEE/3/4. Wendy called 28/11/22 to say two alternative DaGs on WEE/3/4 were being considered by the PC. She will send details for us to request CAMSs. Photos below.



14/11/22 CRFC. Took delivery of gates from new supplier - Secure-a-Field - 15 PGs and 2 KGs. 1 man hour. B. 10 miles.

14/11/22 Cuddington. Briants of Risborough - purchased timber for two kissing gates on behalf of Cuddington Parish Council. 2No 0.9m gates - 1 LH; 1 RH; 2No 2.1mx150x150 gate posts; 8No 1.8mx100x100 posts; 8No 3.6m rails. 1 man hour. B. 15 miles. See photo of loaded trailer above.

15/11/22 Brill. U3A circular walk; encountered six potential S2Gs.

15/11/22 Long Crendon Gate 302 LCR/7/4 CAMS 98491 at SP713087. Completed and submitted CAMS Job Sheet.

16/11/22 Oakley (Little London) OAK/31/2 at junction with OAK/33/1 at SP644125 request from Paul Kilpin for a DaG for the Gutteridge family.

17/11/22 Long Crendon LCR/11/1 at SP698093 dilapidated stile at College Farm. Emailed parish councillor Sandy Hooper to ask if any progress wrt job.

19/11/22 Weston Turville. Jerry met with Martin Watson, parish councillor, to recce nine potential S2Gs. Produced pdf report. 4 man hours. Jerry. 26 miles.

20/11/22 Hulcott. John Chantler emailed to say the Griffin Trust had agreed a future spend of up to £5,000 on footpath improvements.

23/11/22 Centrewire. Received from Jed Wragg two bolt-on D hasps for repairing broken D hasps on gates.



25/11/22 Buckinghamshire Council and Centrewire. Joanne Taylor emailed to ask about our own D hasp fix-kit that we've developed to get around the problem of Centrewire gate failures. She reported that one has failed on The Ridgeway near Chequers. Sent photos of the Centrewire fix kit fitted to a broken gate.



25/11/22 CRFC. Loaded numerous buckets of stones onto trailer. 2 man hours. BM. 10 miles; Michael 10 miles.

26/11/22 Cuddington S2KGs. CAMS 98505 at SP736113 at end of Tibbys Lane and CAMS 98504 at SP737114 at Holyman's Farm. Fitted PostSaver sleeves to 8 posts. 2 man hours. B.

28/11/22 Ray Maguire of the Chiltern Society brought us a second 45° degree kit for Cuddington KGs. Thank you Ray – it will be used in Cuddington.

29/11/22 Impact Signs. Collected three DaG plaques from Aylesbury. 1 man hour. B. 10 miles.

30/11/22 Cuddington S2KGs. Fitted PostSaver sleeves to two 150x150x2.4m gate posts. 2 man hours. BK.

North Bucks rRIPPLE installs 300th gate

In Dorton on 21 September we installed our 300th gate. Well over half the gates have been installed through our Donate a Gate scheme (see <http://www.bucks-wmiddx-ramblers.org.uk/donate-a-gate.html>) which allows us to pass on thousands of pounds to Buckinghamshire

Council to buy more gates which we then install.

When we started out in 2015 with a couple of wheelbarrows we were in awe of those Ramblers groups that had installed 200 gates to replace stiles. Now with our Land Rover and trailer, the support of Buckinghamshire Council,

the Ramblers, landowners and a fantastic team of retirees doing the hard graft we are set for a few more. There's certainly no shortage of stile-to-gate opportunities - and it gets us out of the house and out of mischief!

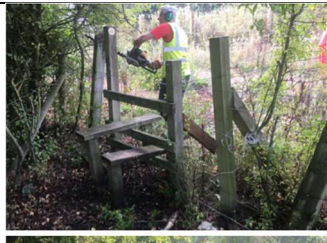
