(ramblers Repairing & Improving Public Paths for Leisure & Exercise)
Activity Report – 2 October 2025 – 14 April 2026

Copies of before & after photos of all work are available on request. Man hours include some travel time. DaG = Donate a Gate. CAMS (Countryside Access Management System) is a reference used by BC (Buckinghamshire Council) for work requests. All work is requested and authorized by Alastair McVail, BC North Bucks PRoW Officer, or Jon Clark, BC Senior Strategic Access Officer. PG = Pedestrian Gate (e.g. Centrewire Marlow or Secure-a-Field Charnwood); KG = Kissing Gate (e.g. Centrewire Woodstock or Secure-a-Field Berkswell). DFU = Dinton with Ford & Upton.

“Installed to NB rRIPPLE standard” means the following: “Pedestrian gate installed c/w 22 mm washer, hinges greased, eye bolt thread copper greased and latch oiled. Latch 8 mm nut replaced with 8 mm security nut. Two 1.8 m x 100 x 100 UC4 15 year Redwood posts c/w Postsaver sleeves are attached to the gate’s H-frame with two 10 mm diameter coach screws. The posts and H frame are tamped in firmly with copious quantities of 20 mm and then 40 mm shingle. Improved by the Ramblers square decals and BC way markers fitted as appropriate.” KG slightly different as only one post needed and as from 30/1/19 we are now putting half a 20 kg bag of Post Fix or Remix on top of each of the two galvanized “feet” of the two hoops. Arisings, i.e. the timber from the old stile is cut up by chain saw and removed from site unless stated otherwise.

9/10/25 Weston Turville Gate 379 Potential PC DaG. TimberKG2PG of WTU/991 CAMS a03747 at SP856107. Demolished dilapidated timber kissing gate on 19/8/25. Installed Secure-a-Field PG to NB rRIPPLE standard. Made good fencing to one side. 3x7=21 man hours. Jerry MichaelJulian.

9/10/25 Weston Turville Gate 380 Pam Dunton DaG. TimberKG2TimberKG of WTU/988 CAMS a03750 at SP854105. Retained existing 150x150 hanging post. Hung refurbished and double Cuprinol 5* treated 1.2 m timber gate in self-closing mode. Built three sided corral utilising brick garden wall for one side. Installed three 1.8 m x 100x100 posts and four rails mitred by Joshua Hilbocus. Good looking job. 3x7=21 man hours. BJoshPeter. 27 miles; Peter 16; Josh 4.

13/10/25 Secure-a-Field. Sent email to Mitchell regarding complaints about the excessive clanging as the gates close. Requested some sort of noise reduction solution. Josh to fit some rubber hose to the D latch in the meantime.

13/10/25 Lewis Developments. Purchased 20 posts and 3 rails. 1 man hour. B. 8 miles.

13/10/25 CRFC. Loaded 12 buckets of stones and 3 gates. Loaded trailer. Sleeved 6 posts. Treated timber gate with Cuprinol 5* wood treatment fluid. 4 man hours. BK. 10 miles.

14/10/25 Weston Turville Gate 381 WTU/982 CAMS a03749 at SP856105 Timber KG replaced like for like. Potential WTPC DaG. Dismantled dilapidated timber, tight Vee shaped corral, KG retaining 150x150 hanging post in good order. Cleared area of elder and ivy overgrowth. Fitted refurbished, jet washed and treated 1.0 m timber gate. Erected four post, four rail, square shaped corral using all new timber mitred by Joshua Hilbocus. Filled in 600 mm gap to one side with four rails screwed to neighbour’s timber fence. Decided corral would benefit from a load of rubble and stones to raise surface to reduce potential for a muddy patch following prolonged wet weather. 3x7=21 man hours. BJoshPeter. 25 miles; Peter 16; Josh 4.

14/10/25 Weston Turville Gate 382 WTU/31851 CAMS a03746 at SP855107 KG2PG Potential WTPC DaG. Dismantled remains of dilapidated timber KG west side of wooded area. Installed PG to NB rRIPPLE standard. Made good timber rails to one side. 3x7=21 man hours. JerryJoePhil. Joe 10 miles.

15/10/25 Bierton BWB/5525 delivered KG to John Chantler in Bierton to prime and paint green for

landowner Mr Stevens. 1 man hour. B. 20 miles.

15/10/25 Bierton BWB/5525 requested S2KG CAMS on Burcott Lane.

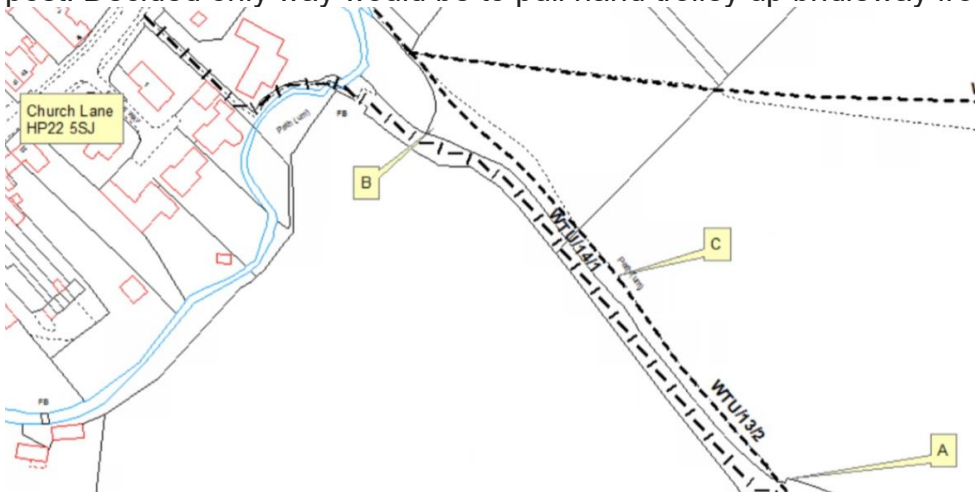
15/10/25 Bierton BWB/5600 requested S2KG CAMS. End of Parsons Lane, Mrs Harris.

21/10/25 Weston Turville Gate 383 - The last of ten gates - WTU/989 CAMS a03745 at SP855107 KG2PG Potential WTPC DaG. Dismantled remains of dilapidated timber KG on 19/8/25. Installed PG to NB rRIPPLE standard. Made good three timber rails to both sides. 4x4=16 man hours. BJoshJoePhil. 25 miles; Joe 10; Josh 4.

21/10/25 Weston Turville WTU/13/2 CAMS a04609 Removal of considerable quantity of barbed wire embedded into surface of footpath creating numerous trip hazards. 3x1=3 man hours. BJoshPhil

21/10/25 Weston Turville WTU/13/2 CAMS a04892 Clearance of overhanging trees obstructing path. 3x1=3 man hours. BJoshPhil

21/10/25 Weston Turville WTU/13/2 CAMS a04598 Disposed of redundant or incorrectly positioned way-marker post at Point B. Reviewed accessibility to Point A to reinstall fallen way-marker post. Decided only way would be to pull hand trolley up bridleway from Church Lane.

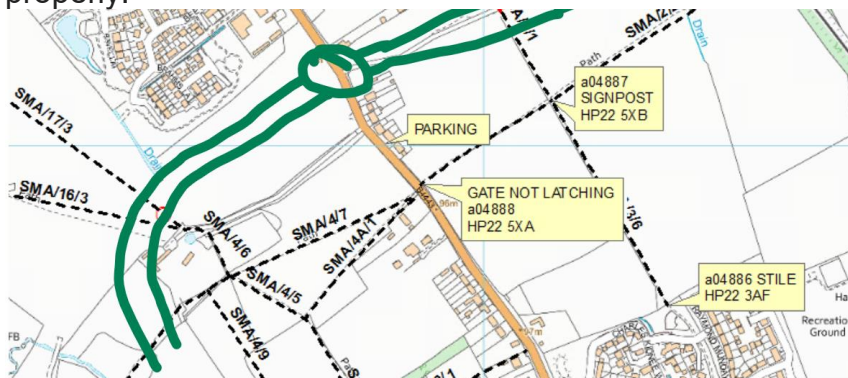

29/10/25 Stoke Mandeville. Emailed Josh to ask him to recce and complete if possible the three CAMSs for Jobs 1, 2 & 3 (See 22/10/25). Not possible.

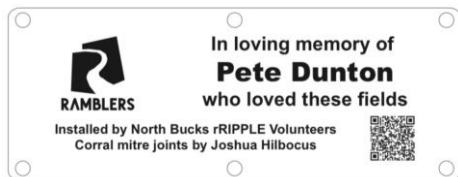
7/11/25 CRFC. Received a delivery of ten gates and three sets of KG hoops from [Bison](#) - formally Secure-a-Field. Loaded trailer with eight buckets of stones and one set of KG hoops. 1 man hour. B. 10 miles.

9/11/25 Stoke Mandeville Job 3 SNA/1520 CAMS a04888 at SP829108 Recce to adjust nuts on gate eye bolt so that gate latches properly - ascertained that the gate's "H" frame is splayed. H frame needs to be pulled in using twisted tow rope method. 1 man hour. B. 10 miles.

13/11/25 Bierton Gate 384 BWB/5524 CAMS a04922 at SP841154 Mike & Claire Griffin Charitable Trust DaG. Dismantled 3-rail, 2-step, 1-hand post stile and adjacent rails. Installed Bison KG painted green by John Chantler to NB rRIPPLE standard less "Postcrete" on hoop feet. Reinstalled 4-rail fence to one side. 5x7=35 man hours. BKJohnJoePhil. 20 miles; Joe 10.

17/2/26 Lacey Green. Enquiry from Andrew Lyon of Chiltern Weekend Walkers wrt S2G DaG. Following some interaction Andrew agreed to try to get us the necessary permissions etc for a S2KG.

19/2/26 Met with Friends of Haddenham to Aylesbury Greenway in Seven Stars, Dinton.

25/2/26 Leighton Buzzard Ramblers RIPPLE. Met with Paul Gransby for a beer and chat in The Hare, Linslade. Offered him opportunity to join one of our gate installation teams. He said Central Beds are concerned about insurance and don't let them install gates. He made contact with our Jerry Michell who is knowledgeable on the subject of work party insurance.

26/2/26 Met with Rob Mole of Bridge Farm, Chearsley to discuss several potential S2Gs and the Greenway to Dinton and Aylesbury. 2 man hours. B. 10 miles.

12/3/26 The Ash Tree, Ashendon. Haddenham RIPPLE entertained several members and wives to dinner who were unable to get to the meal event at The Fox & Goat on 22/1/26.

Met in the pub, Sian Miller & Andy Howes. Discussed progressing footpath improvements and routes for the pub and Ashendon village. Explained that as far as we are concerned it's down to them, the locals, to make all the initial moves, getting landowner cooperation etc.

6/4/26 Toolstation & Screwfix Thame. Purchased replacement bungee straps and some security screws for DaG timber gate plaque. B. 1 man hour. 10 miles.

7/4/26 Mentmore / actually Crafton - Gate 386 MEN/5687 at SP888199 CAMS a05356. Alison Dunmall DaG. Dismantled 4-rail, 2-step, 1-hand post stile. Installed 0.9 m timber self-closing, self-latching gate hung on 2.4 m x150x150 post to NB rRIPPLE standard. 4x9=36 man hours. BPhil-

DavidGMikeK. Very hard ground with buried brickwork. Then horrendous traffic jam in Aylesbury due to RTA at The Bugle Horn pub which explains 9 hour day. 50 miles.

14/4/26 CRFC. Collected numerous buckets of stones, two gates and one set of hoops. Loaded trailer for Marsh Gibbon job on 15/4/26. 2x2=4 man hours. BK. 10 miles.

24/8/23: Currently outstanding, potential and planned work with DaG opportunities available:

Ashendon: PC taking an active interest in RIPPLE, DaGs and developing some circular walks from The Ash Tree community buy-out pub. Sian Miller & Andy Howes are leading this initiative.

Bierton: John Chantler getting landowner permissions for further Griffin Trust DaGs.

Bishopstone: Roger Goodchild gave permission on 9/5/22 for further S2Gs. We need to discuss with him or find a local champion to decide on priorities.

Brill: Several S2Gs on BRI/11/7 through Chinkwell Wood; BRI/11/6 Dorton Grange; BRI/3/4&5 Rushbed Woods to Cuckoo Close Farm. Waiting on Michael Hughes, resident, who may assist with the re-writing of the local footpath walk guides.

Chearsley: Potential S2G CHR/2785 on CHR/12/1 at SP713115 in memory of horse YaYa that died 1/2/22. Rob Mole of Bridge Farm to decide.

Chearsley: Bridge CHR/2803 at SP714097 that links LCR/9/4 and CHR/9/1. Corinne Brownsell the RoW Bridge Inspector made a site visit with Richard Heybrook. She is suggesting a timber bridge over the top of the existing concrete bridge. We are considering a permissive bridge, higher and slightly downstream of the existing bridge.

Cuddington: CUD/8/1 - Cuddington Footpath Team following up with farmer wrt last two stiles.

Great & Little Kimble GLK/27/1 at SP820096 footpath illegally blocked by Travellers' site since early 2020. Steve Miles, of Long Crendon, owns adjacent field but is reluctant to encourage any further land-grab by the travellers. On 23/11/23 Buckinghamshire Council served notice on four residents of Springfield Farm Travellers Site. The council has been prompted by The Ramblers who have served a Form 1 on the council. A newly installed locked gate now blocks access.

Hulcott: HUL/4942 at SP857168 CAMS 93300 on hold. John Chantler getting landowner permissions for further Griffin Charitable Trust DaGs.

Ickford: ICK/3532 on ICK/4/4 at SP649072 Parish Council TimberKG2SteelKG DaG CAMS a05018.

Kimblewick: 5xS2KGs. Waiting since c2020 on request to go ahead from landowner Ted Walker.

Long Crendon: Two awkward and/or dilapidated stiles on LCR/11/1 at SP698093 at College Farm, George Morris is the farmer. Sandy Hooper is the interested parish councillor. Followed up with email on 19/1/23. Need to follow up with the Morris family.

Lower Winchendon: LNW/2594 on LNW/2/2 CAMS a00309 at SP726112. Rob Mole, Bridge Farm, is to decide on whether this will go forward following a face to face meeting with him on 26/2/26. This is close to the Bristol Gate on Aylesbury Road, from Cuddington to Chearsley opposite road up to Nether and Upper Winchendons.

Lower Winchendon LNW/2646. Not sure where or what the problem is. Info requested from Ann Catten, BC PProW.

Marsh Gibbon. LDWA DaG. MGI/6072 at SP647238 CAMS 87669.

North Marston: NMA/46989 at SP775211 CAMS a05160 Ed Kendrick DaG S2G.

North Marston: NMA/92564 at SP775210 CAMS a05161 Oving PC DaG S2KG.

Quainton: QUA/7224 at SP750201 Possible S2KG. Brian Fludgate in negotiation with landowner.

Westcott. Sue Lacey has become local champion but is unwilling to “knock on doors.”

Weston Turville: Church Farm – PC to discuss with farmer and potentially fund S2G.

Whitchurch: WHI/7478 on WHI/7/1 at SP799202. Recce of poor stiles and farmyard showed that the definitive map only shows a finger post and one stile whereas on the ground there is a finger post and three stiles, one of which is dilapidated. Landowner would be happy if we were to repair his stile but not replace any stiles with gates.

Whitchurch WHI/7508 on WHI/59/1 at SP800205 CAMS 84294. Replace two stiles either side of collapsed bridge with PGs. Potentially John Russell DaGs. Agreed with Alastair that BC's work party will now replace both the bridge and the two S2Gs as one job, therefore off our list. Still not done Sept 2025.
